Thank you for your interest in serving in the position of City Commissioner, District 1, to fill the position vacated by Clovis City Commissioner Leo Lovett. The Clovis City Commission will appoint a replacement for the vacated position of Commissioner Lovett at their regular meeting scheduled for 5:15 p.m., Thursday, October 7th, 2021 in accordance with the Clovis City Charter which requires the appointment of a replacement within 30 days of the vacation of said seat. Applicants should attend the meeting prepared to give a 3-5 minute presentation regarding their desire to serve and be available to answer questions from the Commission.
